School Uniform

At the end of last term, we were delighted to hear that once again Bishop Loveday has been awarded the School Games Mark Gold Award! This is in recognition of the competitive sports, attendance at after school sports clubs and the leadership roles that the children take on within PE lessons, sports activities and events. During last academic year, we took over 660 pupils to sports events with 99% of KS1 and 97% of KS2 pupils attending these inter-school competitions. General reminders to parents

- School starts at 8.55am. Please make sure your child arrives in good time to start their day. For safety reasons, if your child is late, you MUST accompany them to the school office to sign them in.
- Please DO NOT park in the school car park. Please park safely and sensibly outside the school
 grounds, avoiding the zig-zag lines. Please pay attention to entrances to private properties. Our
 Community Police Officers are patrolling the area.
- Dogs are not allowed on the school site. Please be mindful if you walk your dog to school. Keep them on a short lead and tie them to outside railings (not on the path side)
- Please ensure your children does not play on the climbing equipment before or after school.
- No smoking of any kind on the school site please.
- Children MUST NOT ride their scooters or bike on the school grounds. Previously we have had injuries from children riding on the busy school playground.
- If your child has suffered vomiting or diarrhoea, they MUST remain off school for a full 48 hours after the last episode.

Thank you, all these measures are put in place to keep your children safe.
