Thank you for retuning the 'One-Time Only' permission slips. Signing this form provides us permission to take the children on visits, sporting events, walks and other off-site trips. Please note that it <u>does not</u> cover overnight residential trips.

Year 5, have started recorder lessons this week. These music sessions follow on nicely after their drumming sessions in Year 4. We have provided each child with a new recorder. If you wish for your child to bring this home, there is a small charge of £5. You can make payment through Parent Pay. Equally, if your child already has a recorder, they can use this for their lessons (please name it!)



We will send a message on Monday afternoon, by text, to let parents know as soon as the coach for Stackpole has arrived. The expected time back on Friday is around 6pm. We will let you know of any delays on their return journey.

On Thursday 19th, Year 3 will be visiting Cadbury World in Birmingham. It's an early start to ensure a full day. Please can all children be ready in school to leave at 8.30am. All children must be in full school uniform, have a packed lunch with plenty to drink. If your child requires any travel sickness medication, you will be required to complete paperwork for them to have the medication given to them for the return journey. Please ensure this is handed in before the day of the visit.

If your child is in Year 6, you are now able to apply online for a secondary school place. The deadline for secondary school applications is **Thursday 31st October 2019**.
