IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ

Attached to this newsletter are two important letters from Mrs Ridley. The first is regarding our updated Attendance Policy. In line with Oxfordshire County Council, all schools are requested to send out the 'Policy' to all parents. Schools must inform the Local Authority when parents take their children on holiday during term time. The Local Authority will be issuing Penalty Notices (£60 per parent, per child) for each holiday taken. In the past, parents have received a letter the first time, informing them that if a further holiday is taken, then a Fixed Penalty Notice will be incurred. This is no longer the case. A Penalty Notice will now be issued after the first holiday is taken.

Please note, the Attendance Policy has been emailed to all parents today, the signature page has come home as a hard copy with the covering letter. It is expected that all parents will sign and return the signature page to confirm their understanding of the 'Policy'.

The second letter is regarding a change to our morning schedule. Please read this, as the changes will take effect from Monday 4th November.
