Mid term reminders

• A reminder to all parents that school starts at 8.55am and finishes at 3.15pm. We have noticed an increase in recorded 'Lates'. Each time your child is late, the time is recorded on the official register, which is a legal requirement for all schools to complete each day. This document is picked up by the attendance team and further action may be taken. Equally, at the end of the day, we have a number of children who have not been collected. This put enormous strain on members of staff who have to then try to locate parents. Staff are often then late to pick up their own children. This is unacceptable, not to mention the upset that your child may suffer at not being collected at

the end of the school day. Please make sure you are here at school in good time to collect your child. Any child left after 3.15pm, will be placed in our Homework Club and a charge of £3.30 per child, per day will be added to your Parent Pay account.

- Please carefully monitor your child's online activity. Children have been talking about watching a YouTube channel called 'Salad Fingers'. This is a highly inappropriate channel for primary-aged children. Sadly, this is only one of many inappropriate channels online. Please monitor carefully.
- Please can all parents who use the Breakfast Club, Homework Club and After School Club on an adhoc basis, let the office know your child is attending. We have had several instances where parents have simply paid through Parent Pay and not let the office know. This is then not communicated to the team leaders. We will always try to accept adhoc attendances where necessary, but we do need prior warning, to make sure we have enough staff to child ratio.
- We still have parents not booking their child's school meals or booking a meal and a lunch box! We are on a real 'drive' to limit food wastage. Please either pre-book a meal (using Parent Pay, remembering the Wednesday midnight cut off for the following week) or bring a packed lunch. **Please not both!**
- A coat is needed for each child now that the weather is getting colder. The children will be outside at play times and lunch times, unless it is heavy rain.
- Please do not buy black trainers as school shoes. We are super proud of our uniform, please keep to the uniform policy. You can find all the information on our website, also Cross Embroidery have full stock of our logoed uniform.
