Warriner have a case of scarlet fever, which is a bacterial infection that can be contagious up to 7 days before symptoms develop. It is easily treated with antibiotics. Signs and symptoms of this condition include flu-like symptoms, including a high temperature of 38C or above, a sore throat and swollen neck glands with a rash appearing a few days later.
