WMAT School Improvement Committee; Implements WMAT strategies through the monitoring and review of attainment and progress data. Develops and implements strategies for shared school improvement. Holds school improvement team led by the CEO to account. Comprised of directors with school improvement expertise. **(Chair – Jennie Perry)**

WMAT Finance and Committee; Monitoring and management of funding and budget. Ensuring all financial decisions are scrutinised and legal responsibilities are met in accordance with The Academies Financial Handbook and other DfE requirements. **(Chair – Brian Heather)**

WMAT Central Services Committee; Monitoring of implementation of WMAT policies and services that can be provided across all of the Academies. With specific responsibility for Health and Safety and Premises. **(Chair – Mark Howarth)**

WMAT Personnel Committee; Monitoring and management of staffing structures and pay. **(Chair – Duncan Raper)**

WMAT Academy Committee - Local Governing Bodies; Implements WMAT strategies and policies in individual schools through the delegated responsibility from the Trustees. Developing and Monitoring of the School Development Plan. Monitoring progress of pupils and the impact of the curriculum through scrutinising data and completing governor monitoring visits into school. LGB committee members are known as "Governors"
