We discussed the latest Head Teachers report and Strategic Priority Progress report from Mrs Ridley, noted the updated School Development Plan, and, with thanks to Neil for leading, scrutinised the school's finances. We welcomed an update from Reverend Sarah on the evolving approach to worship within the school and from Louise her readout of a maths curriculum monitoring visit. And we welcomed the news from James, our health and safety lead Governor, that, following his discussion with them, the developers of the site opposite the school had committed to not making deliveries within school pick up and drop off times."
