Dear Parents/Carers

Quick reminder: current guidelines are, if your child has a high temperature or a cough, do not bring them to school. You should telephone 119 and obtain a test. If the test is negative, we are happy for your child to return to school. If you decide not to have your child tested. They **MUST** remain in isolation for a period of 10 days. Siblings of children showing symptoms must also be kept off school, either for 14 days or until a negative test result for their sibling, and parents and any other member of the household must also self-isolate for 14 days.

PARKING: We have been forwarded photos of illegal parking on zig zags entrances – I believe that these have also been forwarded to the police. Please can I ask parents not to park in the driveway to school, the entrance to the sports' field (where year 6 come and go) or on the zig zag lines. Please help to keep our children safe.

Keeping children safe: Following a recent concern raised by a parent, please can I ask all parents to remind children that if they are out playing, without adult supervision, not to engage in conversations with unknown adults.

Plea for reading books! We are having to quarantine books for 3 days between children taking them home, in line with DfE guidance. This is impacting on the number of books available for children. We have enough for all children to take a book home, but we have had requests for extra books. If anyone has children's reading books that their children no longer use or need, please could you send them into school with your child, in a carrier bag and we will add them to our class libraries.

EYFS children have enjoyed a visit to Broughton Farm this week. They had lots of fun! Year 5 children enjoyed an Egyptian day in school, as part of their learning about Ancient Egypt.

Unfortunately, until year group bubbles are able to 'mix' we are unable to provide hot school meals in the hall. However, we know that the children are keen to have a hot option and so we are trialing a 'hybrid' menu after half term. Monday, Wednesday and Friday, children will have a cooked meal and on Tuesday and Thursday they will continue to have a packed lunch option. The cooked options are meals that children can be packed up in a 'takeaway' style container, i.e. Oriental chicken wraps, chicken burger, fish finger wrap. Meals will be accompanied by a selection of vegetable crudité's, a yoghurt and fresh fruit.
