**Returning to school information – IMPORTANT**

Although the children are returning to school, we ask that you continue to adhere to the current Government guidelines on social distancing. Masks for adults must be worn and we ask that parents leave the school site promptly after dropping off and collecting their children.

We'll announce the winners next week!




