Dear Parents and Carers

Please can I remind you that if a member of your household (or support bubble, where applicable) has any of the Covid symptoms, all other members of the household/bubble must self-isolate until a test has been taken. If you are using lateral flow tests at home, these cannot be used if there are symptoms present – you must go to a test centre. If your child has a high temperature, alongside other non-covid symptoms, please ensure that you then follow the guidance and have a test.

Parents' Evening

Teachers will have the latest assessment information and will share your child's attainment in reading, writing and maths. We are aware that, attainment wise, many children are not where they would usually be at this time in the school year.
