

Governors News:

School Governors (Rob, Revd Sarah, Tracy, Sue, Hayley and Nick) held their first meeting on the new School Year on Monday. We welcomed Revd Nick Fielden as a new Foundation Governor, and gave a vote of thanks to Toby Holland, Ali Bell and Lucy Byford who have all stepped down from the Committee over the summer. We held a discusion with Dr Kay, the CEO of the Warriner on the annual CEO's report to MAT trustees on the last school year and looked ahead to the coming year - particuarly the new Primary curriculum that has been introduced across the WMAT (Warriner Multi Academy Trust) primaries from this September. We undertook a deep dive into what last year's school achievement data could tell us with Dee, Jane and Hayley - and how this was going to inform the teaching focus this year; elected a new vice Chair for the committee (congratulations and a big thank you to Tracy for putting herself forward); discussed and approved the schools polices on Safeguarding, Attendance and Curriculum and received updates from the Head on safeguarding and health and safety.

The Governing Body is currently carrying a number of vacancies. Elections for a new Parent Governor to replace Lucy will take place soon. And we are also have a vacancy for a Foundation Governor. Foundation Governors are specific to Church schools (like Bishop Loveday) and along with the Parent and Teacher Governors make up the Governing body. To be considered as a Foundation Governor your priest/minister must be able to affirm you are a regular worshipper in a Christian church. 
