Dear Parents and Carers

It was lovely to see so many of you at parents evening and thank you to everybody who completed a '2 stars and a wish' questionnaire.

We had so many lovely comments, which I will share with the staff next week and some really good ideas for ways to improve the school. Some of these being: increasing the number of clubs at lunchtime and afterschool, improving the arts (including music lessons, cookery etc.), more trips and visitors and more outdoor learning.

Homework was also a topic of discussion with some parents wanting more, some wanting less, some wanting online and some wanting more paper copies. We will of course review ways of improving homework but please do speak to your teacher if you want to discuss homework further.


