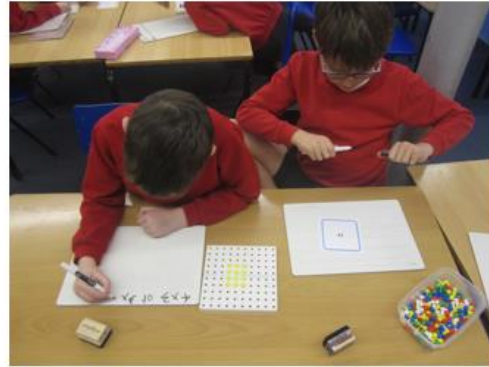

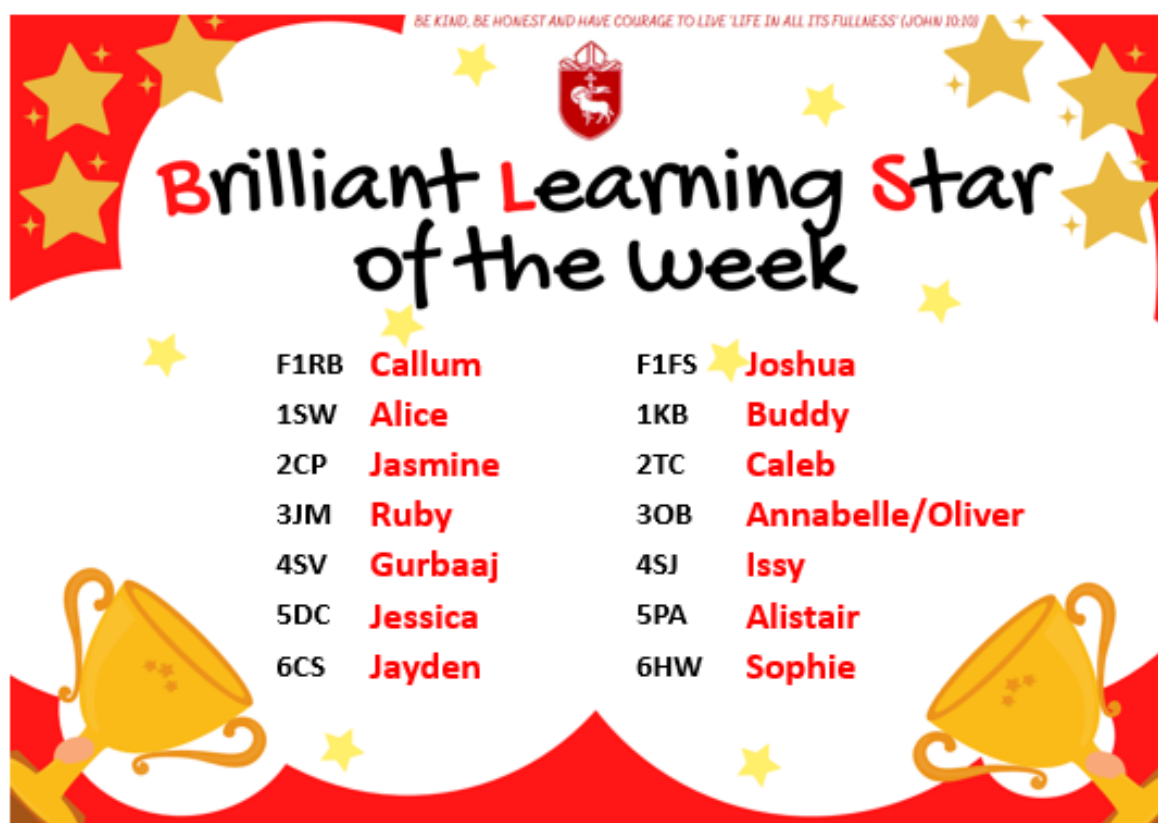
Housepoints:
