Our exciting week of learning:

Early Years enjoyed going to the farm this week. We fed the goats, waved to the pigs and cows, cuddled the lambs and brought back frogspawn so we can watch the life cycle of a frog.





Year 1 have been taking part in a science experiment. They had to extract DNA out of a strawberry!









Year 2 used maps outside to explore and search for gold as part of our history topic. We made 2d and 3d shapes from marshmallows and cocktail sticks to help us learn about the properties of shape in our maths lessons.











Year 2 have also been exploring the properties of 2D and 3D shapes this week. On Monday we made 3D shapes using cocktail sticks and mini marshmallows. This really helped the children to identify how many edges and vertices each shape had.









Year 3 had great fun competing in the Football Tournament at BGN this week.

Year 4 have designed and made the most amazing Ancient Egyptian plaster tiles this week. We designed our hieroglyphic pattern, added this to foam tile, built a wall around it with clay and then poured plaster on top to create our own tile. We got messy and had lots of fun. Stanley, Harriet and Charlotte R have received a certificate and belt for successfully passing the Yellow Belt at the Freestyle Martial Arts Masters Council.


