
We have an enormous pile of un-named lost property, over the Easter break please can we ask you to name all your children's school clothes so that they can be returned to their owner.

Early Years children have enjoyed tasting hot cross buns, making Easter treats, singing to their parents while wearing their Easter hats and taking part in a family treasure hunt.



Year 1 have made their sock puppets and had a lovely time doing so. They have worked so hard.







Year 2 This week it has all been about fractions in year 2! We shared ladybirds equally into halves, quarters and thirds and found fractions of different numbers. We learned about unit and non-unit fractions and had fun making pizzas in the Pizzeria.



Year 3 have been writing diary entries about a boy called Perilus and one of his many adventures! We have also been going fraction crazy in maths.

Year 4 This week, as part of our Egyptian topic, the Year 4 children have designed, made and evaluated a shaduf. A shaduf was a hand operated device for lifting water out of the River Nile during Ancient Egyptian times. Some of the children even tested their design to see if they could lift water out of a bowl. The children used a pivot and lever mechanism and have thoroughly enjoyed this part of the topic.




