Our exciting week of learning:

Early Years have had a fantastic time at the Cotswolds Wildlife Park this week. We have seen and heard lots of different animals and learned about where in the world they come from. We loved going on a train around the park and looking at all the animals.

Year 1 have enjoyed writing about different endings to the fairy-tale Goldilocks and have continued their yoga programme in PE. They have looked at everyday materials and described their properties and uses. In Art they made links to their History learning of the Great Fire of London, by painting flames and are learning how to layer warm colours to create a flame page by painting curved lines and flicks. This has linked to all our learning about The Great Fire of London! We used this piece of artwork as our inspiration.

Year 4 have started to explore electricity and circuits this week. They have used components of a basic circuit to see if they can make a light bulb light up.

Year 5 have been super scientists and have been investigating plant reproduction.

Sports:

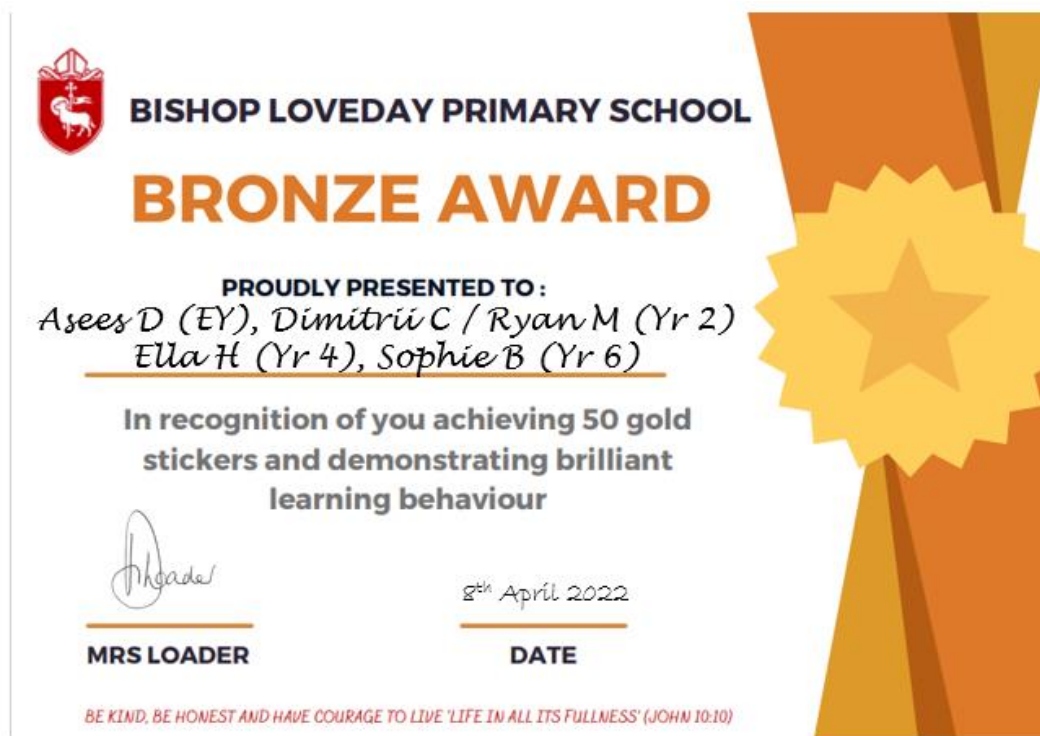
The running and Commonwealth Games clubs on Mondays and Thursday will NOT run next week due to the Sports Leaders being on residential.
