### Our exciting week of learning:

Early Years have had a fun week finding out about our Solar System. We have made rockets, split pin astronauts and explored the space station role play area. The children have learnt about the moon, the sun and know that we live on planet Earth.

Year 1 have been writing newspaper reports about the Great Fire of London. They have also been investigating materials in Science suitable for making cushions and bedcovers (apologies we are doing this Friday afternoon so won't have photos ready to go into the newsletter) and finding fractions of shapes.

Year 2 are starting to look at materials this term and think about what materials different things are made from. In science this term, we have been learning about lifecycles and enjoyed having their own caterpillars in class. They observed them closely and were amazed as they metamorphosised into butterflies! This week we released them into their natural habitat. A very exciting experience for the children!



Year 3 have started to learn about their new and exciting topic - The Vikings!

Year 4 have been learning about plastic pollution in preparation for writing persuasive letters to Supermarkets, requesting them to reduce plastic waste. Since learning about the effect it is having on our environment, the children decided they wanted to pick up litter during break times. They have also been learning about open and closed circuits and have made their own circuit using paper clips.

Year 5 thoroughly enjoyed their adventure into space on Tuesday, visiting the planetarium. They travelled through the galaxy and stopped off at each planet for a truly unique learning experience.

Year 6 Some year 6 children participated in the Cricket festival this week, while others enjoy a game of rounders in the sunshine. They have also starting writing about the Deserted Island Get Away!


