Cricket Finals in Kidlington: The second lot of County finals for the Dynamos cricket teams from years 5 & 6 took place this week at Stratfield Brake Sports Ground in Kidlington.

Despite some good batting displays and great determination in the field, both results didn't go in their favour and they finished 3rd in their group. A final match against Chesterton finished the day and they ended in joint 6th overall.

Their final game was for 3rd place and it was against Hill View- again a close game, but this time it finished with a BLS win. All players came away with a T-shirt and certificate. 
