Our exciting week of learning:

Early Years have had a fantastic first session of forest school today investigating the great outdoors and we have also been mixing up our animal groups and getting to know our other friends.

Year 1 have been learning how to write instructions. We started off by making yummy jam sandwiches and thought about which adverbs of time and bossy verbs we could use for each instruction. In science we have thoroughly enjoyed looking at the trees in the school grounds. We looked at their size and leaves. We asked and answered questions about these wonders of nature! Perhaps you could look out for different types of trees when you are out and about?

Year 2 have been learning how to write instructions. We started off by making yummy jam sandwiches and thought about which adverbs of time and bossy verbs we could use for each instruction.

Year 3 have been working on description and dialogue. The children have generated some amazing adjectives for their descriptive writing which we will begin next week. The children all seem very enthusiastic and happy to be working with their new teachers and TAs.

Year 4 in History have been learning about a local study and really enjoying the Battle of Edge Hill.

Year 5 have been learning about forces in Science and measured objects using a Newton meter. In DT they have been learning about Archimedes, a Greek mathematician, and the importance of maths in engineering and science.

Year 6 have had Bikeability sessions this week. They have enjoyed learning about road safety and applying this in real life situations. The Bikeability Team also commended our children on their behaviour and listening - well done year 6!




