Our exciting week of learning:

Early Years have had lots of fun celebrating Diwali and Bonfire night. They have made sparkly pictures, Diva lamps out of clay, made and eaten Firework toast and breadstick sparklers.

Year 1 have been exploring acrostic poetry this week and having a go at writing their own firework poem.

Year 2 relaxed and enjoyed taking part a yoga class! It was themed around 'under the sea'. We listened to relaxing music and stretched our bodies to make different poses; mimicking creatures who live in the ocean. It was very relaxing! The children were very calm and focussed and were able to hold the poses for sustained periods of time. Very impressive!



Year 3 have had fun in our English lessons this week. We have learned about alliteration, onomatopoeia, similes, imagery and metaphors! We are learning about these English techniques in preparation for some Iron Man poetry which we will be starting next week! The children are learning to spell onomatopoeia through the Old Macdonald had a farm tune - hopefully some of them can remember the spelling!

Year 4 have all been amazing at their first swimming lesson and were awesome at listening to all of their new instructions. 4CS have started their new music topic and will start to become experts in playing the djembe drum in no time.

Year 5 have explored performance poetry this week based on the poem Fill The World. The children performed the poem using actions, a clear voice, volume and rhythm - awesome.

Year 6 residential children have had a fabulous week at Cumulus outdoor centre. The weather was mixed but it didn't stop them from having lots of fun including a visit to the Tank Museum, indoor climbing wall, tag archery, indoor campfire, fishing off Swanage Pier, evening disco and celebrating Harry P's birthday. Year 6 children who stayed in school have also had a fun week including researching how animals were used during WW1, made their own Banksy graffiti art, looked at how light works and explored the story of the Gunpowder Plot. 
