Our exciting week of learning:

Year 1 have been preparing for Christmas in RE by thinking about what the shepherds might have said to Mary and Joseph as they arrived at the stable. They have also enjoyed holding animal poses in yoga to accompany a story.

Year 2 have been perfecting their lines and polishing up their singing for their Christmas production. In Literacy we have been reading George's Marvellous Medicine. After Grandma drank the medicine, some astounding things occurred. Year 2 became journalists and interviewed George to find out what had happened to Grandma! 
