Absence Procedures:

If your child is absent you must contact us as soon as possible, either by phone, email or the website, on the first day of absence and any subsequent days and ensure you explain the reason for absence; do not just say that your child is unwell.

Medical/dental appointments should be made outside of school hours, unless emergencies or other unavoidable cause.

Lateness:

Poor punctuality is not acceptable. If your child misses the start of the day they can miss work and do not spend time with their class teacher getting vital information and news for the day. Late arriving pupils also disrupt lessons, it can be embarrassing for the child and can also encourage absence.

The school day starts at 8:55a.m. and we expect your child to be in class at that time. Registers are marked by 9:00a.m. and your child will receive a late mark if they are not in by that time.

At 9:10 a.m. the registers will be closed.

Our exciting week of learning:

Early Years have been completing lots of Christmas craft activities and practicing our Christmas play and songs. On Monday we walked to Kingsfield Nursery to watch their Nativity play. We all enjoyed it very much.

Year 1 children have loved performing to their parents/carers this week and have been learning about 2D and 3D shapes in maths.

Year 2 have just absolutely loved performing their Christmas play- The Fireside Nativity! We hope you all enjoyed watching it as much as we have enjoyed putting it together for you.

Year 3 have been excellent in our Maths lessons where we have been using our knowledge of 2s, 4s and 8s times tables. Lots of skip counting and chanting of our times tables going on. The children have also had some great discussions while we reflected on our big question for this term in our RE lesson.

Year 4 have been working so very hard in their Christmas Play rehearsals and it's coming together fantastically! They have also been continuing their persuasive writing in Literacy and are excited to write some amazing leaflets about experiencing the northern lights.

Year 5 been learning about Alexander the Great and his importance in history. In art we have been learning about the graphic designer/illustrator Mike Karolos.

Year 6 have enjoyed workshops this week from the Cherwell Theatre Company on protective behaviours and saying no, linking to PSHE and the work of SCIB (Safeguarding Children in Banbury).
