Early Years have been continuing with our farm activities. We have also been thinking about Mother's Day and have talked about the special things that our Mums, and the adults that care for us, do for us every day. Another group of children went to the farm today.

Year 1 and 2 had a visit form Banbury Fire service this week who taught us all about what to do if we found ourselves in an emergency. We learned how to test our fire alarms and what sort of things we can do in our homes to stay safe. The children loved climbing aboard the fire engine and even had a go at spraying the hose! We learned all about the important equipment on board and what it was all used for. Some of the children were even inspired to become fire fighters themselves when they grow up!









Year 3 have enjoyed writing their Roman solider poems this week and have used all their experiences from Roman Day to write from the perspective of a Roman! They have also enjoyed starting a new unit of Maths. They have been experimenting with Mass and who could find the heaviest item to weigh!

Year 4 have enjoyed writing an exciting narrative based on their class text Varjak paw and thinking about memory boxes in RE.

Year 5 have been developing their understanding of why Christians celebrate Holy Communion and how it links to the Easter story. In guided reading, we have also had an introduction to The Black Country Living Museum ready for our trip next Friday.




William B (3DC) has been awarded his karate blue belt. This is an extremely challenging belt for someone of William's age and his parents are so very proud of him.

- The formal closing dates for the competition is mid-day Saturday24th March 2023
- Each entrant is required to submit their entry illustrating "The Beauty of Architecture.
- They should submit their entry as a jpeg digital file to Tim Bryce (email address tim.bryce@hotmail.co.uk) as an attachment to their completed application form (see attachment).
- The images should not be compressed but in a reasonably high resolution, image file between3 and 15mb.

The images will be reviewed by a judging panel of five individuals including two local professional photographers. The Judges will consider technical merit, content, composition, imagination, and style. There are three separate age groups - Junior 7 to 10 years old, intermediate 11 to 13 years old, Senior 14 to 17 years old, and the judges will select a winner and a runner up for each group.

Pease note the applicant should not be over the upper age limit on 31st August 2023.

This competition has been developed by Rotary International, G.B. & Ireland and is considered to be of interest to young students studying or living locally and is free to entry.
