Our exciting week of learning:

Early Years have continued learning about Easter. We have made and decorated Easter biscuits and made a palm leaf. We walked down to church for the Easter experience and had out Easter assembly followed by a family activity outside. The last group of children visited the farm today.


FoBLS News:
