Our exciting week of learning:

Early Years have been making the most of the sunshine and exploring our amazing outdoor area, which included a scavenger hunt for wild animals! We have learnt about South America, Africa and Oceania. We all enjoyed having our group and individual photos taken and finished our week in forest school.

Year 1 have been working with fractions and finding half of a shape and a number in Maths. They have completed fitness challenges in PE and used Google Earth to find physical features of the UK in Geography including the White Cliffs of Dover, the Jurassic coastline in Dorset, Mount Snowdon in Wales.

Year 2 have been comparing seaside holidays from the past to holidays that we might have at the seaside today. Some of our Year 2's were rather intrigued by a Punch and Judy show or a donkey ride along Bournemouth beach! We have also been solving lots of word problems in maths and learned how to separate items in a list using commas in our literacy.

Year 3 have been working hard this week learning how to tell the time in both analogue and digital. They have also been proudly writing their information texts about Anglo -Saxon life.

Year 4 have been learning about electricity and had fun exploring circuits this week. They made predictions whether different circuits would work and then recorded their observations. Everyone demonstrated fantastic scientific skills, well done!




