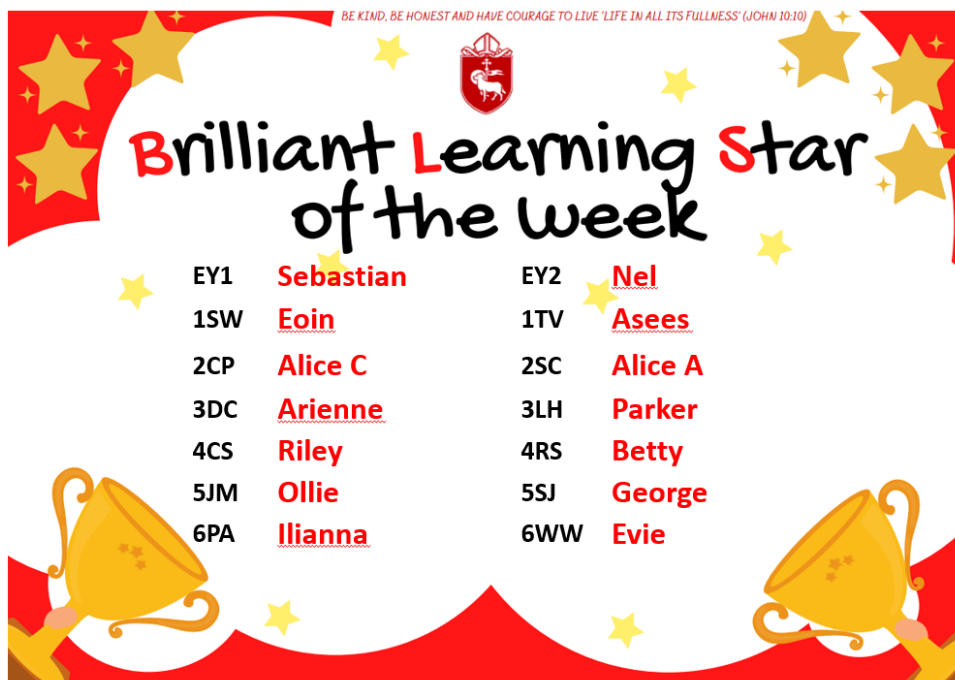

Our exciting week of learning:

Early Years have had a fantastic week learning about summer. We also had lots of fun with the Year 1's on Thursday morning for the Multi Skills Festival. We took part in different activities and worked as a team.

Year 1 had a marvellous morning on Thursday. They took part in a multi-skills festival with Early Years and the Year 5 and 6 sports leaders and spent the morning completing team challenges in their houses. In the classroom they have been writing reports on London and its landmarks, linking their learning with their Geography knowledge. They also have been creating their own shared special place in RE, describing what makes it special and who they would share it with.

Year 2 joined forces this week with some of the Year 6 children to complete our DT project and construct our car models. The children have been working on these for months and were delighted with the final products! Using Purple Mash, each child designed their own car and printed it onto card. They then had to use their cutting and folding skills to turn the net into a 3D car model. The children have learned all about the how car design has changed over history and what the different parts of cars are called. They attached the parts of their cars together, with some help from the Year 6's, then had lots of fun testing them out in the hall.



Year 3 have had a fantastic last couple of weeks of term. Despite being tired and ready for the summer hols, the children have worked incredibly hard in all of their learning and we are so proud of them. We are finishing our writing unit to entertain in English, completing and drawing bar charts in Maths, and tackling tricky texts in Reading, and much more. We hope that the children have a great summer holiday and you all have a well-deserved rest. We have loved being their Year 3 teachers! All the best!

Year 4 completed their water cycle design and technology project with moving parts to demonstrate precipitation and evaporation.
