Our Week of Learning:

Early Years last group of children had an amazing time at the farm. The children enjoyed cutting up fruit to make their fruit salad which they all enjoyed eating. We finished our week off with our Harvest Festival where we sang, showed off our artwork and finished the afternoon creating a family piece of autumn art.

Year 1 Wow! What a busy and brilliant first term Year 1 have had settling in! This week we had a lot of fun following instructions to make our own bubble wands. We used pipe cleaners to make a shape in the wire, choosing carefully our imperative 'bossy' verbs; bend, make, blow, watch. We dipped our shapes in the bubble mixture and made hundreds of bubbles to float away! We have been reading our class text The Owl Who Was Afraid Of The Dark this half term, and enjoyed thinking about all the different ways that Plop the baby barn owl is persuaded to like the dark. 1CW enjoyed toasting marshmallows around the campfire in their final Forest School session of this term. 1TS had fun in their final music lesson of this term, learning about rhythm and pulse.

Year 2 have had a great week. The children have been working so hard in literacy writing their baby dragon recounts. The children also sang beautifully at our Harvest service in church.

Year 3 The children have enjoyed practicing the Harvest songs and performed them beautifully at the church service today.

Year 4 have finished writing their letters to author Cressida Cowell whose book we have been reading as our class text. We also enjoyed singing at our Harvest Festival today.

Year 5 have had a super busy week making and evaluating their Archimedes screws in DT. They have also been adding numbers (up to 5 digits) and solving missing number addition problems. The Year 5 children have also enjoyed learning the Harvest songs and singing with Year 6. We look forward to exploring the 'King Midas' story in more detail when we return after half term.

Year 6 have been working on multiplication and have enjoyed writing biographies about the explorer Ernest Shackleton. They have also enjoyed decorating their beanie hats.

Sports:

We have arranged for The Activators, from Cherwell District Council, to provide an afterschool club for **KS2** which will take place each Tuesday between 3:30pm – 4:30pm, for six weeks, running from **Tuesday 7th November - Tuesday 12th December**.

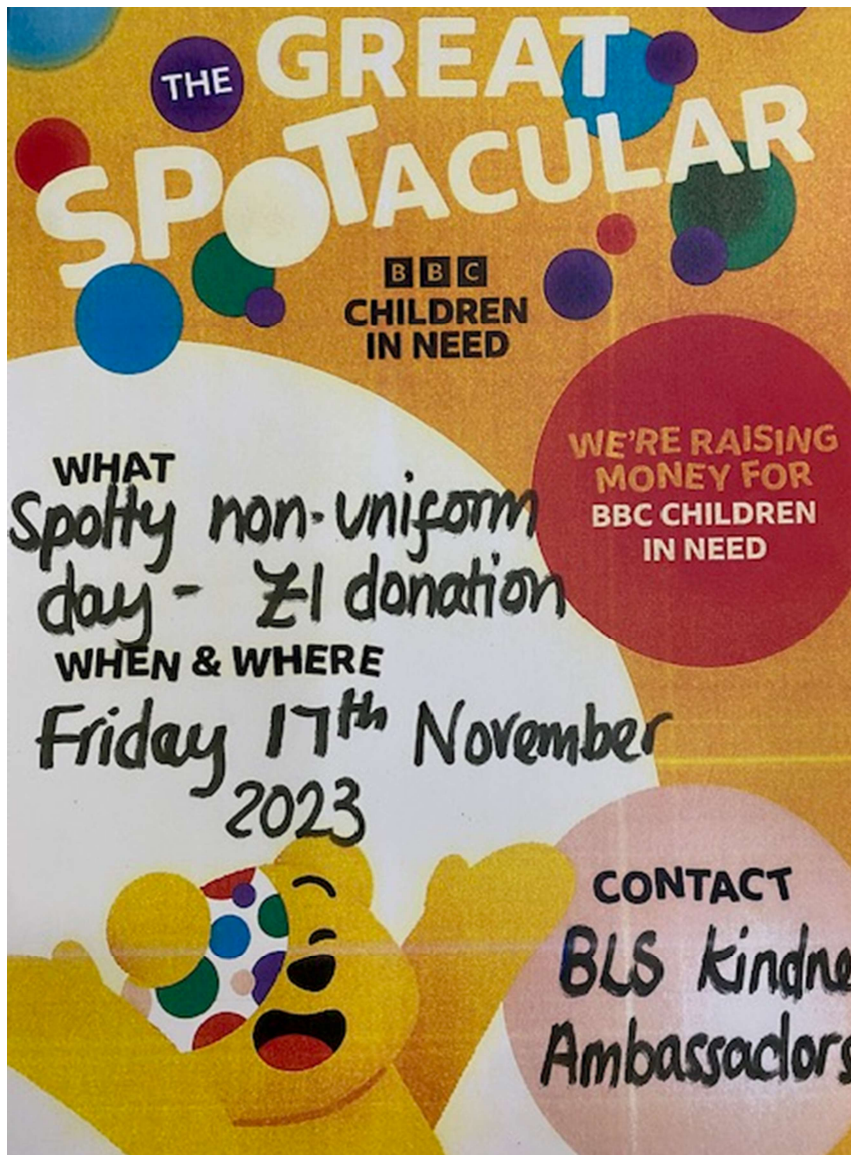
