The READING CHAMPIONS wrote to us requesting new books for the library. They had the pleasure of adding them to the school library last week.


#### Times Tables Rock Stars

All the children enjoyed dressing u as rock stars, the money raised from this has supported the subscription fee for both PURPLE MASH and TTRS




### Play and storage equi playgrounds.
