#### Our Week of Learning:

Early Years this week we have been leaning about animals native to England. As a class we sorted animals into groups to show when they were awake – diurnal or nocturnal. In our outside area we went on a hunt matching animals with their footprints.

Year 1 had a super trip to BGN to take part in a MultiskillIs event. We enjoyed taking part in a circuit of activities which included: aiming at targets, catching, bouncing, running, dribbling and balancing. We have also been busy writing our letters to 'The Earth' and our teachers are very proud of our writing.

Year 2 have been learning about the climate and weather patterns in the rainforest. Following their trip to the Living Rainforest last week, they were able to imagine what this humid, tropical climate would actually feel like and wrote a postcard to one of their friends or family members describing what the weather was like. We also looked at different types of Torahs in Synagogues and compared them.

Year 3 children have been learning about volcanic eruptions in Geography linking this to their History, using primary evidence to learn about the eruption of Vesuvius in 79AD.


Year 4 have enjoyed finishing their Tadeo Jones adventure stories and have created their own version of the Jabberwocky in art.



Year 5 have been immersing ourselves in our theme of Earth in Space by looking at information texts, learning how the understanding of the solar system has changed over time, reading about key figures in space exploration, and discovering how seasons are formed. We are looking forward to seeing who wins the TTRS tournament – well done to those pupils who took part.

Year 6 have produced some excellent writing from the point of view of a Second World War evacuee. They have all worked hard to include a range of vocabulary, punctuation and emotive language. These pieces of writing will be displayed in our classroom and the children should be very proud of how creative their work is. We are all very proud of them!
