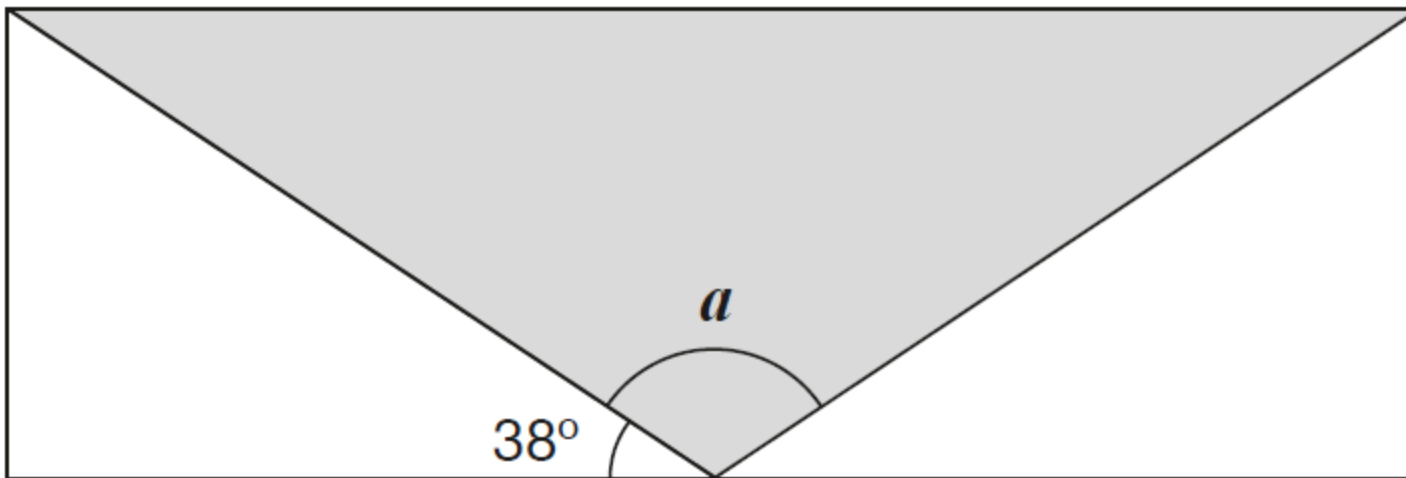

Reasoning

- Maria bakes buns and sells them in boxes. She uses this formula to work out how much to charge for one bag of cakes. **Cost = number of cakes × 12p + 25p for the box.** How much will a box of 15 cakes cost?

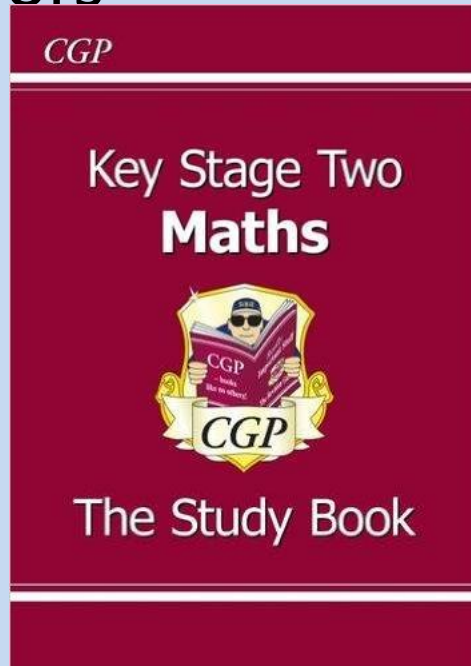
Reading

- Several line – writing in sentences
- Longer more detailed answer – 2 or 3 – need to explain their opinion.
- Selected answers : tick, draw lines to, or put a ring around answer.
